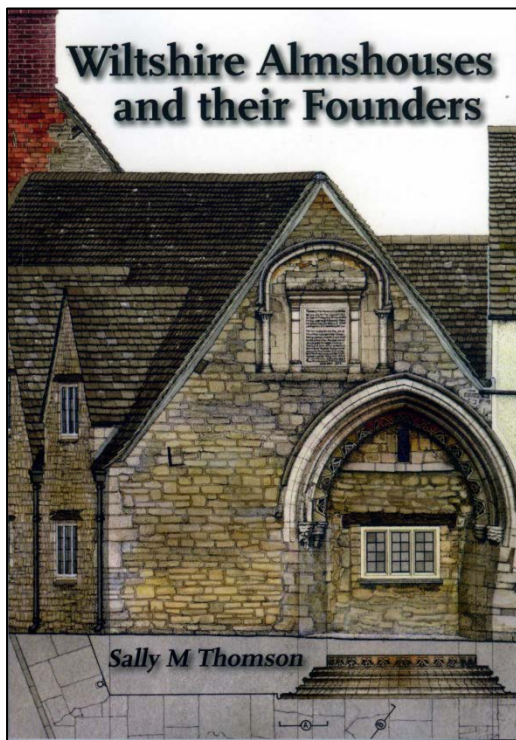


# Wiltshire Almshouses and their Founders

This new book in the Wiltshire Buildings Record series on building types is the first comprehensive study of the almshouses of the county.



After the Reformation in the mid-16th century provision for the poor, especially the elderly was provided in many communities by the building and endowment of almshouses by private individuals.

The introduction includes a description of the institutions which had been set up in the Middle Ages, 'hospitals', leper colonies and Bede Houses.

The gazetteer covers the 77 known Wiltshire post-Reformation almshouses with their histories and constitutions and describes the buildings, illustrated by photographs, maps and plans.

The second section describes what is known of the lives of the generous men and women who were the founders. This is illustrated by portraits and church memorials.
